

All Starz Academy Privacy Policy

The privacy policy describes what personal data we collect and what we do with that personal data. Personal data is information that can be used to identify you or your child.

What personal data do we collect?

All Starz Academy collects details from the parent/carer regarding the student at time of registration including:

- Child's name, date of birth, home address, academic school
- Name, home/email address and contact number of parent/carer
- Any relevant medical conditions of child (ie. asthma, allergies, etc)

Why do we collect this information and how is it used?

- Child's name, date of birth, academic school – we collect this information to identify the student and find the most appropriate class.
- Home address, email address and phone number(s) of Child/Parent/Carer – we collect this information to distribute any necessary correspondence, invoices and other communications relating to All Starz Academy and your child, or to contact you in the case of emergency.
- Details of medical conditions – we collect this information for health and safety reasons to ensure that we are aware of anything that might put your child at risk and the attention that may be required.

Which third parties do we share this information with?

- If your child is participating in a performance, the above information will be sent to the relevant Local Authorities/Show Organisers. This is a requirement so that they can confirm we are following the correct safeguarding procedures regarding the children's performance activities and, where necessary, to issue performing licences.
- We also share the required personal data of parents that apply for voluntary DBS and Chaperone licenses with Local Authorities/Governing Bodies.

Who can access All Starz Academy Data?

- The data we collect is stored securely at our offices and is accessible only by the School Principal and Reception Staff.
- Telephone numbers and email addresses of students/parents/guardians are also kept on site in a lockable folder in case of emergency.

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect.

Please note we do not share your/your child's data with any 3rd parties for marketing purposes. Your data is used only in relation to the running of the dance school and our performances.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system. Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
